We are extremely pleased to once again announce the Guthrie Dairy Youth Leadership Award. This cash award will be given annually to 4-H or FFA members involved in youth dairy programs or activities and who need financial assistance in order to participate in workshops, conferences, field days, or any other dairy-related activity that would enhance their leadership abilities. Examples of these types of programs are Junior Dairy Breed Association Activities, Southeast Dairy Youth Retreat, or any other dairy-related program where leadership can be developed. Depending on the number of deserving applicants and availability of funds consideration may be given to awarding more than one scholarship. We are open to different possibilities, so be creative!

Dr. Guthrie retired from the Animal and Dairy Science Department at the University of Georgia in 2000, and it was his wish that he be remembered in this way. Dr. Guthrie was a major force behind the Youth Dairy Programs in Georgia for more than 20 years. Besides overseeing the 4-H and FFA Dairy Judging programs and developing the very successful Georgia Commercial Dairy Heifer Program, Dr. Guthrie has been an unwavering supporter of developing leaders for the Georgia Dairy Industry through the 4-H and FFA Programs. He has been involved in all facets of these youth dairy programs, and many successful producers look back and recognize Dr. Guthrie and his efforts for at least part of their current success.

Enclosed is an application form which must be filled out and signed by the student's County Extension Agent or Ag Ed teacher. The signing teacher or agent must also attach a letter of recommendation. In some cases, an applicant may enclose letters from both of these people. The completed application and attached letters of recommendation must be received to Heather Shultz's office in Athens, **no later than January 22, 2010**. We will have the applications judged and will announce the winner or winners no later than January 29th.

Thank you for your help in spreading the word about this scholarship and for your part in helping us identify these outstanding youth involved in dairy programs. We look forward to receiving your applications.

**Guthrie Dairy Youth Leadership Award
Guidelines**

- 1) Recipient must use the award money to attend the designated program, activity or tour as indicated in their application, no later than one year from the application deadline, i.e.) No later than January 22, 2011.
- 2) Applicants must be enrolled in the 9th - 12th grade for the 2009 - 2010 academic year to apply.
- 3) Failure to complete the designated leadership development program or activity by January 1, 2011 will result in forfeiture of the award, and all monies will be returned to the scholarship fund.
- 4) Upon completion of the designated activity, program or tour for which the money was awarded, the recipient must submit a report of not more than one page detailing how the Guthrie Youth Dairy Award enhanced his or her leadership abilities.
