

Georgia 4-H Hippology Clinic

Saturday October 23, 2010

Description

The Georgia 4-H Hippology Clinic is designed to introduce the rules and format of the Hippology contest is currently offered through the 4-H Horse Program. The primary objective of the Hippology Contest is to provide in a friendly but competitive setting, an opportunity for youth enrolled in 4-H to demonstrate the breadth of their knowledge and understanding of equine science and management, and in particular the practical application of this knowledge and skill. This activity would provide the 4-H horse project members the opportunity to utilize knowledge and skills developed from other project activities such as Quiz Bowl, horse judging, speaking and demonstrations, and general horse program.

This clinic is open to both youth and adults. All attendees will participate in a mock contest in the afternoon.

Enrollment will be limited to the first 80 participants. A minimum of 25 received, paid reservations will be required to offer this program. An email will be sent out after the deadline of October 13th to confirm if the program has reached it's minimum number.

Fees

Registration for the clinic will be \$5.00 per youth, and \$10.00 per adult. All adults will receive rulebooks.

Lunch

Lunch will not be provided, but at least a one hour lunch break will be given to participants. They may bring their own lunch, or may visit local restaurants.
