I, the accepted, do hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth in the consignment contract, and swear that all the information furnished regarding this entry is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, and I do agree and specifically warrant, unto sale management and also unto any subsequent purchasers that I have absolute and complete title to the entry listed on this contract. I further warrant that any signature or electronic information given on any document pertaining to this entry is proper and correct. I have read and clearly understand and agree to abide by all the established conditions of this sale.

Trail Contest fee \$35 This fee is per equine and in addition to consignment and limited to first 100 per sale day

Equine Consignment Fee \$125 Consignors agree to pay a fee of \$125 per consignment.

Consignments and trail payable Through US bank Merchant Services accepting Visa and Mastercard by continuing through contract and horse information page.

Equine commission 7% and pass out fee \$40

Horse trailer consignment fee \$35 Horse trailer consignors agree to pay a fee of \$35 per trailer consigned and will be charged 6% commission on sale price. Seller reserves the right to pass out the sale of the trailer with no pass out fee. Trailers will be offered at 3:00 p.m. on Sat. May 7 and 3:00pm on Sun. May 8.

1. The consignor releases JUSTinHORSES LLC and Justin Schneider Auctioneer, Sale Facility, Auctioneers, employees and representatives from any and all responsibilities, liabilities, law suits, or legal proceedings arising from the sale of this horse, mule or pony hereinafter will be termed as equine. If legal action is initiated against JUSTinHORSES LLC or Justin Schneider Auctioneer involving the sale of this equine, the consignor agrees to fully indemnify JUSTinHORSES LLC and Justin Schneider Auctioneer from such suit, including legal fees and cost.
2. All equine that are not gaited (meaning they walk trot and canter) consigned entries are eligible to compete in the Trail Horse Contest 9:00 a.m. on Saturday May 7 or All equine that are Gaited (meaning that they have a natural four beat, single footed or other breed specific gait) 9:00 a.m. May 8, 2011 (\$2500 + sponsorship perks in prizes both days.). The fee to enter the Trail Contest is \$35 and is in addition to consignment fee. The Contest will be limited to the first 100 consignments that enter. The first 100 equine entered in The Trail Contest will be the first 100 offered at auction.
3. All entries must have a 12 month negative coggins test and a 30 day health certificate. Entries may be any breed, and are not required to be registered. Entries must be at least four (4) years of age on the date of the sale. No stallions, crypt orchids, or ridgelings. Mares must not be pregnant. No Substitutions with the sale companies discretion for consigned horses that have deceased after consignment. The consignor agrees to pay a consignment fee of \$125 which is non-refundable after acceptance by sale management. The consignor is legally bound by the electronic acceptance but agrees to sign a printed copy of this contract when arriving at sale premises. When it is applicable the transfer report must be signed by the owner or the legal agent. In the case of multiple transfers, the consignor will be responsible for all fees necessary to complete the transfer to the owner of the horse at the time of consignment. The transfer fee to the buyer will be the only transfer fee paid by the buyer. Sellers of non-registered horses will be required to sign a bill of sale.
4. Upon the sale of the horse to a bona fide buyer, the consignor agrees to have deducted from any proceeds the commission of \$40 or 7% of the final bid whichever is greater. The commission is in addition to the consignment fee. Once the horse is on the sale grounds, **all sales transactions must be processed through the sales office.** All equine must go through the sale ring. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** If the final bid is not accepted by the Consignor, no commission is charged; however, a \$40 no sale fee will be assessed. The consignor will be charged a commission for any equine consigned to the auction that was not sold to an active, registered buyer at the sale within 14 days following the auction. This transaction must be processed through the sales office to insure protection of the consignor and the Buyer.

5. Proceeds from the sale will be paid by check the day of the sale. The consignor agrees that if the payment of this equine is incomplete for any reason by the buyer, Sale management shall not be liable for the payment or collection of the sale proceeds, recovery, or re-sale of the equine. The Consignor understands that Sale management does not guarantee the validity, payment or collection of any instrument received in payment of the sale proceeds of any equine.

Representation Policies:

6. The consignor shall declare any and all unsoundness, vices, physical defects and/or cosmetic alterations prior to The sale of the horse understanding that these statements will be announced. This shall include, but not be limited to, defects with eyes, breathing, cribbing, weaving, nerving, ridgeling, founder, overbite, navicular disease, ringbone, or cryptorchid, or any artificial enhancements. **A horse sold with any of these conditions that was not announced at the time of sale CAN be rejected by the Buyer within 3 days of the date of sale and returned to the consignor at Buyers expense. This rejection must be accompanied by a certificate from a qualified equine veterinarian and agreed upon by sale management, the Consignor and the Buyer. If the horse is rejected for any unsoundness or other misrepresentation, the commission will not be refunded to the Consignor.** There is no guarantee between consignor and buyer of compatibility or disposition.
7. Sale management recommends that horses that are the lineal descendant of AQHA stallion IMPRESSIVE be Tested for **HYPP (Hyper-Kalemic Periodic Paralysis)**. The results of this test will be printed in the catalog and announced at time of sale.
8. Permission is hereby granted to the Sales Management to edit or add to the Owners Statement furnished.

Ownership and transfer

9. Consignor warrants clear title to the equine or trailer with transfer of ownership in order. Sale management must be informed of any and all liens at time of consignment. The consignor retains ownership until the gravel falls. The Consignor is responsible for any feed, care and presentation of the equine. Upon sale of the equine, consignor will leave a halter for the buyer. Should a Buyer default on the purchase or reject this equine after it is sold, the Consignor agrees to allow this equine to be auctioned a second time at the first available opportunity during the sale. Sale management, sales facility, ar anyone else directly or indirectly involved with this sale assumes no liability for the equine whatsoever.
10. The Consignor has the right to turn down the final bid as a no sale. If the Consignor allows the Buyer to sign the sales ticket, the equine is **sold with no exceptions.**

Sales Management:

11. Equine will be sold in catalog order. Sale management has the authority to assign stalls, reject any equine, make any announcements or additions to enhance the sale.
12. The Consignor releases JUSTinHORSES LLC and Justin Schneider Auctioneer, Sale facility and all its employees, representatives, and spectators from any responsibility for any accidents that may occur to equine or equipment, or for the loss by fire, theft, injury or death to any human or animal in any way or manner.
