JANUARY 21, 2012

1. Any exhibitor 21 years of age or under is eligible to show.
2. All swine must be blood tested PRV and Brucellosis negative within 30 days of the show and have an official health certificate. All out-of-state swine must have a prior permit number on the health certificate. Please be timely in bleeding your hogs to facilitate the return of your health certificate prior to show date (GA diagnostic vet lab closes for Christmas holidays).
3. Entries are open to the world. Barrows and gilts are eligible. No boars! *SWINE WILL NOT BE SHOWN BY BREEDS OR SEX AT THIS SHOW. BARROWS, GILTS, PUREBREDS AND CROSSES SHOW TOGETHER.*
4. Each entry must have be ear tagged for purposes of breaking classes. Pigs must be ear tagged prior to turning in the weight card.
5. Swine will be weighed by the exhibitor and a weight card will be turned in. All first and second place class winners will be re-weighed as they leave the ring and the weight must be within 5% of the weight card. If the pig is not within

5%, the next hog will move up and the hog not making weight will be moved to last in class.

6. Swine do not have to be entered in the state show to show in this show.
7. The barn will open at 7:00 am on Saturday January 21, 2011. All weight cards must be turned in by 11:30 am. Classes will be broken, and the show will begin promptly at 1:00 pm.
8. There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor.
9. Exhibitors are free to pen on their trailer. Please denote on the entry form if you intend to pen on the trailer or utilize a pen in the barn.
10. *THE SHOW MANGEMENT ASKS THAT THE EXHIBITORS ASSIST IN THE REMOVAL OF BEDDING FROM THE PEN AT THE END OF THE SHOW. NO STRAW IS TO BE USED AS BEDDING.*
11. All entries must be postmarked by January 18, 2012. The entry fee is \$50.00Per pig. The committee reserves the right to refund money to entries if the number of entries exceeds pen space. Trailer penning will permit more hogs and a larger purse. Early reply will insure your spot at the show. All entries should be mailed to; **Floyd Peters, Mitchell County Young Farmers, 1000 Newton Road, Camilla, GA 31730.** Entry fees cannot be switched from one exhibitor to another.
12. There will be no showmanship at this show.
13. Prize money will be paid to the *OVERALL* top three pigs in the show.
14. Divisions will be divided evenly among the classes, as far as possible. Division winners will compete for Grand Champion honors. The judge will select Grand and Reserve Champions, and then he will rank the next hog to allow for proper distribution of premium monies.
15. *THE RULES COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INTERPRET ALL RULES. DECISIONS OF THE JUDGE AND THE RULES COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL.*
