This free, two-day event is hosted by the Department of Environmental Protection in partnership with the Florida Forest Service - Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services, the U.S. Forest Service, the City of Tallahassee and the Southern Trailriders Association. The Expo's goals are to introduce young equestrians to land conservation ethics on both public and private lands, to encourage youth to advocate and volunteer on behalf of equestrian trails issues and to inspire this next generation of equestrians to become active trail users.

On Saturday, join the fun and learn through a series of hands-on activities about trail development/maintenance activities and riding opportunities. A Sunday trail ride, following the same trails that participants worked on Saturday will be led by the Southern Trailriders Association. Trail ride participants must bring their own horse, proof of negative Coggins test and properly fitted helmet.

Members of the U.S. Pony Clubs, 4-H Horse Clubs, Trail Associations, Horsemen's Associations, MFHA member hunts as well as other youth equestrians are encouraged to participate. There is no fee for the event, but registration is limited in order to preserve the quality of the program.
