For purposes of riding instruction, participants will be divided into RIDING GROUPS. (Exact groups will be determined by applications received)

Check ONE group (If 4-H'er participates in multiple disciplines, please rank riding groups in order of preference): Please check the Riding Group which you feel best fits your riding ability and interest. Using a scale of 1-4, 1 being high, 4 being low. Instructors may change 4-H'ers to the appropriate group once the 4-H'er completes their evaluation on Sunday, June 14th.

- () STOCK SEAT I (beginning, Western saddle) -- Cloverleaves, Junior and Seniors with limited experience, including beginners and intermediates. This group will be divided into two groups at the School.
- () STOCK SEAT II (advanced, Western saddle) -- Juniors and Seniors -- Advanced riders, including reining
- () WORKING CATTLE (advanced, Western saddle) -- Juniors and Seniors with more advanced riding skills; the following activities may be covered: cattle basics, working cow horse, team penning, team sorting, some reining, roping, and goat tying
- () SADDLE SEAT – Trotting **If a minimum of 12 participants per Saddle Seat are not confirmed the groups will be combined.
- () SADDLE SEAT – Non-Trotting
- () HUNT SEAT ON THE FLAT (English saddle, no jumping) -- Cloverleaves, Juniors and Seniors. This group will probably be divided into two groups at the School.
- () HUNT SEAT OVER FENCES (English saddle, jumping) -- Juniors and Seniors, some prior jumping skills required
- () CONTEST EVENTS I -- (Barrel Racing, Stake Race, Cone Weave, etc.) Open to Juniors and Seniors, must have Contest Events experience. Limited experience for the rider and/or horse.
- () CONTEST EVENTS II -- Experienced Contest Eventers with an experienced Contest Eventing horse.

The 4-H'er's skill level may be evaluated by their Horse Club Leader or Riding Instructor (if necessary). The next portion of the application is designed to briefly outline the candidate's riding skills in order to place them in the proper Riding Group.

Registration Fee: \$325 -- Includes admission to all lectures, demonstrations and riding labs. Fee also includes health and accident insurance for the week. 4-H members will be housed in Perry at a local motel and served meals at the Agricenter. The \$325 covers 4 nights lodging and meals beginning with supper on Sunday, June 13, and ending with breakfast on Thursday, June 17. This price also includes the 4-H Horse School T-shirt!

Refunds for the deposit (\$100) will only be given for the following reasons: (1) There is a doctors note excusing 4-H'er due to illness/injury, (2) There is a death in the immediate family, (3) Other extenuating circumstances will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Refunds (\$225) made ONLY IF space is filled by another 4-H'er. Refunds (\$225) must be requested in writing by June 1, 2010.

Each club member must bring a horse. This horse can be owned, borrowed or leased. 10' X 10' stalls will be provided for each horse at no additional charge. The 4-H'er must furnish their own **feed, feed bucket, water bucket, grooming equipment, tack and pitchfork** for stall work.

The program for the week is a full one. All 4-H'ers will be expected to attend all labs, lectures, demonstrations and evening programs. 4-H members will not be permitted the use of cars or trucks while attending the school.
