

## State 4-H Congress Dress Code



State 4-H Congress is a professional affair. 4-H'ers should be dressed neatly and appropriately at all times. Clothes should be in good condition without frays or holes. Undergarments must be worn but not seen. Pajama bottoms are not considered pants and should not be worn outside of hotel guest rooms. Midriffs should not be exposed. No one's clothing should be a distraction to others participating in the event.

### **Specific guidelines include:**

#### **Opening Assembly (Tuesday)**

Better school clothes. Slacks, collared shirts, dresses, and pant suits. No shorts, jeans or t-shirts. Tennis shoes are not appropriate. Scholarship recipients should have on coats & ties and dresses.

#### **Leadership Banquet (Tuesday pm)**

Dress is better Sunday dress with coat & tie for gentlemen & dresses for ladies.

#### **Presentations & Portfolio Judging (Wednesday)**

Coat & tie, dresses & pant suits or appropriate demonstration apparel

#### **Free Time Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday**

Collared shirts tucked in, shorts and belts for free time activities. T-shirts and short shorts are not appropriate.

Bring a swimsuit if you wish to swim in the hotel pool. A cover up must be worn to and from the pool. Boxers and cut off shorts can not substitute for swimwear.

#### **Wednesday Night at Six Flags**

State Congress t-shirts with shorts. State officers may wear officer shirts. No short shorts.

#### **Thursday Breakfast Banquet**

Come dressed for your tour. Check the schedule At the least better school clothes and professional casual dress including collared shirts, dresses, and pant suits. No shorts, jeans or t-shirts. Tennis shoes are not appropriate for meal or tours.

#### **Thursday Donor Tours**

Check your tour location for appropriate dress. Some will require professional dress. Others will require professional casual dress. Shorts, t-shirts, and tennis shoes are not appropriate for tours. In either option, be sure that your appearance showcases the best of Georgia 4-H

#### **Thursday Annual Banquet**

Dressier dresses for ladies. Many girls will wear formal dresses. Coat and tie for men.

#### **Thursday Night Recreation**

Shirts with shorts or blue jeans. No short shorts. Shoes must be worn.

#### **Friday Morning Winners Meeting**

Collared shirts tucked in, shorts and belts for free time activities. Short shorts are not appropriate.
