Subject: State Indoor Archery Tournament
February 27, 2010

The Georgia 4-H S.A.F.E. Program will hold a State Indoor Archery Event at Fortson 4-H Center on Saturday, February 27, 2010. Following are details for the event:

Format: The State 4-H Event will consist of a 330 round with 30 arrows shot in 10 ends of 3 arrows at a distance of 18 meters. The event will be open to any eligible 4-H'er registered as a member of a county Project S.A.F.E. Archery Program. Separate classes for novice, recurve and compound archers will be offered in Cloverleaf, Junior and Senior age divisions. Novice class (cloverleaf only) will shoot from a distance of 9 meters. An adult age division will be offered for coaches and parents that would like to participate. Counties should refer to the Archery Section of the Georgia 4-H Awards Guidebook for other rules, safety information, and range commands as they relate to the Georgia 4-H Program. Cloverleaf age division will use an 60cm single spot target. All other age divisions will use a 40cm single spot or 3 spot target. Scoring will be conducted "Clover" style (Vegas scoring) where the "X" ring will be counted as an 11.

Pre-registration: Pre-registration for the event is due by February 10, 2010. Counties should go to the Event Registration Site and registrar all archers, both youth and adults, who would like to participate in the event. The site will open on January 18, 2010.

There is a \$15.00 fee for all archers. When registering, you will need to select the division/class for each archer and select their first and second choice of flight time. Housing and meal options will also be available from Fortson 4-H.

Flight Times: Flight times will be assigned prior to the event. Selecting a flight time through the online registration does not guarantee assignment for the event. Assignments will be posted prior to the event so counties/families can plan their travel

arrangements. Each flight will consist of 30 minutes for practice and 2 hours for scoring rounds.

Housing/Meals: Fortson 4-H Center will offer housing and meals for those counties interested. Housing for Friday evening will be offered at \$12.00. Breakfast will be provided at a cost of \$6.50 per person and Lunch at \$7.00 per person. Housing and meals must be pre-ordered through pre-registration. Additional meals will not be available for purchase on site. Off site locations for lunch are 20-30 minute drive. A snack bar will be operated by the 4-H Center throughout the day.

Awards: Competition for the State indoor event will be individual competition only. Awards will be presented to the top 4-H'ers in each age division and class and will be based on participation numbers in each class. Awards for the event will be determined by the event committee. Adults will participate for bragging rights only.

Insurance/Medical Release Forms: 4-H Insurance for the event will be included in the registration cost. Each archer, youth and adults, must complete a Medical Release Form to turn in at registration.

Onsite Registration: Onsite registration will be held in the Fortson Gym from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. on Friday evening and will continue on Saturday morning beginning at 7:00 a.m. All participants should plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before their scheduled flight time.

Fortson Notes: Seating and viewing capacity during the match will be limited. We ask that seating be reserved for the coaches and family members of those individuals that are participating in the current flight.
