

# Georgia 4-H Project S.A.F.E. 2012 .22 Rimfire Sporter E-Match

**Eligibility:** All 4-H'ers registered as a member of a county Project S.A.F.E. Rimfire program may participate. 4-H'ers must meet eligibility guidelines set forth in the Georgia 4-H Awards Guidebook. Competition is for individuals only.

**Age Divisions:** The Postal Rimfire League will be offered to Senior 4-H members only. There will be separate classes for "O" and "T" Class.

**Entries/ Deadline:** To register, county Extension Offices must complete the online registration through the 4-H Event Registration Site by February 10, 2012. Under event registration, the match is listed as "22 Rimfire E-Match." The entry fee is \$3.00 per participant and should be submitted to the State 4-H Office and postmarked by February 10<sup>th</sup>.

**Multiple Entries:** A 4-H'er may enter multiple classes with in their age division. For each age class entered, a 4-H'er must be entered separately in the event registration site. A separate registration fee is due for each entry.

**Course of Fire:** Each contestant will complete two stages consisting of 60 rounds as outlined by the CMP Rimfire Sporter Program. For each stage, 4-H'ers will complete 10 shots slow fire and 2 series of 5 shots rapid fire in the Standing position at 25 yards and in the Prone and Kneeling Position at 50 yards. For complete rules, counties should refer to the 4-H Competition Guidelines for .22 Rimfire Sporter.

**Match Dates:** Each stage should be completed and scores entered for that stage on the Event Registration Site by the following dates:

Stage 1 – March 9<sup>th</sup>

Stage 2- April 6<sup>th</sup>

**Targets:** Targets or replacement centers designated as "CMP Rimfire Sporter Target" or "CMP B-19" will be used. Counties are responsible for providing their own targets.

**Scoring Targets:** Each target shall be marked with the name, date fired, course number and position. Targets should be scored following CMP guidelines by at least two coaches. Scores for each target should be recorded in the top right-hand corner.

**Submitting Scores:** After the completion of each stage, the county Extension office must enter all scores from the score sheet onto the event registration site by the deadline date. Each form should be signed by the coaches responsible for scoring targets prior to submitting to the county Extension Office. ***Mailed or emailed scores will not be accepted.***

**Awards:** Awards for E-Match participation will be present during the Target Challenge Weekends. Medallions will be presented to the top three shooters in each class based on the total aggregate score of the two stages. Ties will be broken based on Standing Scores. In addition, each 4-H'er that completes both stages of the E-Match will receive an award pin. Award Pins will be given to counties during registration at Target Challenge Weekends.
