

Georgia 4-H Project S.A.F.E. 2012 Air Rifle E-Match

Eligibility: All 4-H'ers registered as a member of a county Project S.A.F.E. Air Rifle program may participate. 4-H'ers must meet eligibility guidelines set forth in the Georgia 4-H Awards Guidebook. Competition is for individuals only.

Age Divisions: The Air Rifle E-Match will be offered to both Junior and Senior 4-H members. Juniors will compete in sporter class and separate classes for sporter and precision will be offered for Seniors.

Entries/ Deadline: To register, county Extension Offices must complete the online registration through the 4-H Event Registration Site by February 10, 2012. Under event registration, the match is listed as "Air Rifle E-Match." The entry fee is \$3.00 per participant and should be submitted to the State 4-H Office and postmarked by February 10th.

Course of Fire: Each contestant will complete two stages consisting of 60 rounds fired from different positions at a distance of 10 meters or 33 feet. Each Stage will consist of a separate 3x20For each stage, 4-H'ers will complete 6 targets with 10 shots per target. For complete rules, counties should refer to the 4-H Competition Guidelines for Air Rifle.

Match Dates: Each stage should be completed and scores entered for that stage on the Event Registration Site by the following dates:

Stage 1 – March 9th

Stage 2- April 6th

Targets: Targets will be the ten bulls eye target designated by the National Three Position Air Rifle Council as NC-AR10. Counties are responsible for providing their own targets.

Scoring Targets: Each target shall be marked with the name, date fired, course number and position. Targets should be scored following CMP guidelines by at least two coaches. Scores for each target should be recorded in the top right-hand corner.

Submitting Scores: After the completion of each stage, the county Extension office must enter all scores from the score sheet onto the event registration site by the deadline date. Each form should be signed by the coaches responsible for scoring targets prior to submitting to the county Extension Office. ***Mailed or emailed scores will not be accepted.***

Awards: Awards for E-Match participation will be present during the Target Challenge Weekends. Medallions will be presented to the top three shooters in each class based on the total aggregate score of the two stages. Ties will be broken based on Standing Score. In addition, each 4-H'er that completes both stages of the E-Match will receive an award pin. Award Pins will be given to counties during registration at Target Challenge Weekends.
