

Georgia 4-H Project S.A.F.E. 2012 Archery E-Match

Eligibility: All 4-H'ers registered as a member of a county Project S.A.F.E. Archery Program may participate. 4-H'ers must meet eligibility guidelines set forth in the Georgia 4-H Awards Guidebook. Competition is for individuals only.

Age Divisions: The Archery E-Match will be offered to Cloverleaves, Junior and Senior 4-H members. Separate classes will be offered for recurve and compound archers in Cloverleaf, Junior and Senior divisions. A Novice Division will also be offered for Cloverleaf participants.

Entries/ Deadline: To register, county Extension Offices must complete the online registration through the 4-H Event Registration Site by February 10, 2012. Under event registration, the match is listed as "Archery E-Match." The entry fee is \$3.00 per participant and should be submitted to the State 4-H Office and postmarked by February 10th.

Course of Fire: Each contestant will complete two stages consisting of 36 arrows shot in 6 ends of 6 arrows at different distances. For complete rules, counties should refer to the 4-H Competition Guidelines for Archery. The stages for each division and class will be as follows:

Division/Class	Distance	Target Face
Cloverleaf Novice	20 meters	122 cm
Cloverleaf Recurve	20 meters	122 cm
Cloverleaf Compound	30 meters	122 cm
Junior Recurve	40 meters	122 cm
Junior Compound	40 meters	80 cm full face
Senior Recurve	50 meters	122 cm
Senior Compound	50 meters	80 cm center spot

Match Dates: Each stage should be completed and scores entered for that stage on the Event Registration Site by the following dates:

Stage 1 – March 9th

Stage 2- April 6th

Targets: Targets will be full color, FITA-style targets. See above chart for correct target face.

Scoring: Scoring shall be conducted in the same manner as outlined by the 4-H Competition Guidelines for Archery, pages 5-6. Arrows should be scored by adults prior to being pulled. Scores for each end should be recorded on the official score sheet.

Submitting Scores: After the completion of each stage, the county Extension office must enter all scores from the score sheet onto the event registration site by the deadline date. Each form should be signed by the coaches responsible for scoring targets prior to submitting to the county Extension Office. ***Mailed or emailed scores will not be accepted.***

Awards: Awards for E-Match participation will be present during the Target Challenge Weekends. Medallions will be presented to the top three shooters in each class based on the total aggregate score of the two stages. Ties will be broken based on total X's. In addition, each 4-H'er that completes both stages of the E-Match will receive an award pin. Award Pins will be given to counties during registration at Target Challenge Weekends.
